Letter from Paul

The 2019-20 Budget is the next step in the Morrison Government's plan to build a stronger economy and secure a better future for all Australians.

We are guaranteeing the essential services that Australians rely on, including record funding for schools, hospitals, and infrastructure.

We are delivering \$158 billion in tax relief to encourage and reward hard-working Australians by more than doubling the low and middle income tax offset from 2018-19.

We are ensuring that medicines are more affordable, with \$331 million included in this Budget for new and amended medicines on the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme.

And this budget will deliver the first budget surplus in twelve years - a surplus of \$7.1 billion in 2019-20. Most importantly, the Morrison Government has been able to deliver these measures (and more) **without increasing taxes.**

There's plenty more good news for Australians in the Budget.

- Strengthening Medicare by providing \$309 million to improve access to diagnostic imaging, and \$187 million to increase patient rebates for 119 GP service items on the Pharmaceutical **Benefits Scheme**
- Funding more hospital services with our \$1.3 billion Community Health and **Hospitals Program**
- Delivering improved student outcomes through record funding for schools




In St lves announcing \$1.3 million in funding for Playgroups Australia to continue delivering its PlayConnect Playgroups & Better Start Community Events programs.




Commonwealth funding for schools

BUDGET 2019

Lower taxes for hard-working Australians and small businesses

- Immediate tax relief for low- and middle-income earners of up to \$1,080 for singles or up to \$2,160 for dual income families to ease the cost of living
- Eliminating net debt by 2029-30, so that future generations are not burdened by today's spending
- Backing small and medium-sized businesses through tax relief and by increasing and expanding access to the instant asset write-off
- Making sure multinationals and big business pay their fair share

Investing in our community

- Record transport infrastructure investment of \$100 billion over the next decade
- Getting Australian families home sooner and safer
- Tackling congestion, with new road and rail projects targeting the worst affected areas around the country
- Strengthening the freight and supply chains that Australian businesses rely on

- Taking action to support affordable, reliable and sustainable energy by unlocking pumped hydro storage through Snowy 2.0 and the Battery of the Nation
- Striking City and Regional Deals to build the future of our cities and regions
- Planning for Australia's population into the future
- Supporting Australia's farmers, businesses and communities through natural disasters



The Government will invest \$42.5 million in 2018-19 to expand the Community Sport Infrastructure Program to ensure that more Australians have access to local sporting facilities.

I recently presented the Northern Sydney & Beaches Hockey Association with a \$500,000 grant towards a new hockey centre at Barra Brui oval in St lves, as part of the Community Sport Infrastructure Program.
